JON NOYES Music Director & Founder

Jon Noyes is FCCC's Music Director, Founder and Chamber Singers Conductor. He served as a public school music educator for 40 years as well as an Adjunct Professor of Music at Fairfield University. Jon was named Choral Director of the Year by The Connecticut Chapter of the American Choral Directors Association for 1998. Mr. Noyes received Bachelor of Music and Master of Music degrees from the Hartt School of Music at the University of Hartford. He holds a fourth-year certificate from the Kodály Musical Training Institute and is a Past President of the Southern New England Kodály Educators.

CHRIS ANNE POWERS Concert Choir Conductor

Chris Anne Powers is a public school music educator at Cos Cob School in Greenwich, where she co-directs the Greenwich Public Schools Honor Choir. As an Endorsed Teacher Trainer for the Feierabend Association for Music Education, Chris presents professional development workshops and FAME certification courses around the country. In 2019, she received the Greenwich Distinguished Teachers Award. Chris received her undergraduate degree in Music Education as well as her Kodály Certificate from The Hartt School and a Master's Degree in Education from Sacred Heart University.

LISA BETTKE Chorale Conductor & Accompanist

Lisa Bettke was a music specialist at McKinley School in Fairfield for 30 years and conducted the first-ever CT Children's Honors Choir for the CT Music Educators Association. She received a B.A. in Piano Performance and French from Gettysburg College and an M.S. in Music Education from the University of Bridgeport. Ms. Bettke served as President of the CT Chapter of the American Orff-Schulwerk Association and as a Regional Representative on the National Board of Trustees. As an accompanist, she has worked with Doreen Rao, Henry Leck, Mary Goetze, Joan Gregoryk, Jean Ashworth Bartle, and Rollo Dilworth.

ASHLEY ZADRAVECZ Chorus Conductor

Ashley Zadavec is a music educator in the Fairfield Public Schools. She holds a Master of Music Education from The Hartt School of Music with a concentration in Choral Conducting, a B.S. in Music Education from Western Connecticut State University concentrating in Voice, and is certified in the Kodály Method. Ms. Zadavec has been singing in choirs from a very early age, including 5 years with the FCCC, and continues to perform at First Church Congregational in Fairfield as Soprano Section Leader and Cantor, and in the professional Hartford-based chamber choir, Voce.
